| EQUALAN | IVERMECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones). 1 tube - sufficient to treat 600kg | 8 weeks | Kills All - Except Tapeworm & encysted small redworm larvae |
| VECTIN | IVERMECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones) 1 tube - sufficient to treat 600kg | 8 weeks | |
| ERAQUELL | IVERMECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones) 1 tube - sufficient to treat 700kg | 8 weeks | |
| EQUITAPE | PRAZIQUANTEL 1 tube - sufficient to treat 600kg | | Tapeworm only. SAFETY HAS NOT BEEN STUDIED IN PREGNANT OR LACTATING MARES |
| EQUALAN DUO | PRAZIQUANTEL & IVERMECTIN Eqvalan 1 tube - sufficient to treat 600kg Equimax - 1 tube sufficient to treat 700kg | 8 weeks | Kills All including tapeworm. DOES NOT KILL ENCYSTED SMALL REDWORM. Equimax Can be used from 2 weeks old. Evalan Duo - safety not tested in stallions, or foals <2mths old |

| EQUEST | MOXIDECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones) 1 tube - sufficient to treat 575kg | 13 weeks | Kills All – Except Tapeworm. Effective against encysted small redworm. Can be used from 4 months old Not licensed for use in donkeys |
| STRONGID P | PYRANTEL TARTRATE | 4 weeks | Double dose kills tapeworm. Can be used from 8 weeks old. Kills ADULT stages of large and small redworm, Ascarids & pinworm ONLY. Does not kill bots or encysted small redworm larvae |
| PYRATAPE | PYRANTEL EMBONATE 1 tube - sufficient to treat 600kg | 4 weeks | |
| EQUEST PRAMOX | PRAZIQUANTEL & MOXIDECTIN 1 tube sufficient to treat 575kg | 13 weeks | Kills all in a single dose Licensed for use from 6 ½ months old Not to be used during pregnancy and lactation in mares Not licensed for use in donkeys |
| PANACUR | FENBENDAZOLE | 4 weeks | 5 day course kills encysted small redworm larvae. Some resistance worldwide. DOES NOT kill tapeworm. Can be used in suckling foals. |
