<b>EQUALAN</b>	IVERMECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones). 1 tube - sufficient to treat 600kg	8 weeks	Kills All - Except Tapeworm & encysted small redworm larvae
<b>VECTIN</b>	IVERMECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones)	8 weeks	
<b>ERAQUELL</b>	IVERMECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones)	8 weeks	
<b>EQUITAPE</b>	PRAZIQUANTEL		Tapeworm only. SAFETY HAS NOT BEEN STUDIED IN PREGNANT OR LACTATING MARES
<b>EQUALAN DUO</b>	PRAZIQUANTEL & IVERMECTIN	8 weeks	Kills All including tapeworm. DOES NOT KILL ENCYSTED SMALL REDWORM. Equimax Can be used from 2 weeks old. Evalan Duo - safety not tested in stallions, or foals <2mths old
<b>EQUIMAX</b>		8 weeks	
<b>EQUEST</b>	MOXIDECTIN (Macrocyclic Lactones)  Sufficient to treat horses weighing up to 575kg	13 weeks	Kills All – Except Tapeworm. Effective against encysted small redworm. Can be used from 4 months old Not licensed for use in donkeys
<b>STRONGID P</b>	PYRANTEL TARTRATE	4 weeks	
<b>PYRATAPE</b>	PYRANTEL TARTRATE	4 weeks	
<b>EQUALAN</b>	PRAZIQUANTEL & IVERMECTIN	8 weeks	Can be used from 2weeks old.
<b>EQUIMAX</b>		8 weeks	
<b>EQUEST PRAMOX</b>	PRAZIQUANTEL & MOXIDECTIN  Sufficient to treat horses weighing up to 575kg	13 weeks	Kills all in a single dose Licensed for use from 6 ½ months old Not to be used during pregnancy and lactation in mares. Not licensed for use in donkeys
<b>PANACUR GUARD</b>	FENBENDAZOLE	4 weeks	5 day course kills encysted small redworm larvae
